Overview

Matchroom Pool is delighted to launch the Matchroom 9-ball Pool World Rankings. The rankings will become the cornerstone of the game globally to recognise 9-ball as the main commercial form of the game sanctioned by the World Pool Billiard Association.

The Matchroom 9-ball Pool World Rankings will promote clear, fair, and concise rules to grow the sport across the world and will:

•Create a clear structure throughout the game

Form qualification for all Matchroom promoted events

•Feature 9-ball events outside of Matchroom events

 Feature events promoted by Diamond Billiards, Pat Fleming and more

Throughout 2022, players will earn ranking points based on prize money earned in Matchroom 9-ball Pool World Ranking events, enabling them to fairly qualify for events and receive seedings in tournaments based on their success. For 2022, the Top 32 is set out by a Rankings Committee who will continue to monitor the status throughout the year.

This document sets out the full calendar of events for 2022, which may be added to during the year, and gives detailed event format information and qualification processes for the eight events promoted by Matchroom Pool.

7 before 4 more players are eliminated

- The remaining 6 play each other once more on day 8 before the top four contend the playoffs

- All group matches race to 5, alternate break

WORLD POOL CHAMPIONSHIP

Event Overview

Multiple tables, non-stop action and Matchroom's unrivalled staging makes the World Pool Championship a dramatic, unpredictable, and exciting event which isn't to be missed.

The best 128 players from around the world take part, meaning tough matches from the very start of the Double Elimination Group Stage which halves the field. The group stage features 16 groups of 8 players who play double elimination for a place in last 64, from which point the tournament is a straight knockout.

Event Overview

Lending its format from the US Open, the UK Open will see players fight through a seeded double elimination stage led by the top 32 on the Nineball World Rankings. Only the last 16 will make it through to the straight knockout stage.

The World Cup of Pool brings 32 nations together as two-player teams compete for national pride, the title and their share of a \$250,000 prize fund. The tournament is a straight-knockout format leaving no room for error.

The first 16 nations will be picked by the WPA before the next top 8 nations off the Nineball World Rankings will automatically receive an invite. The remaining 8 will be unseeded wild cards.

Event Overview

The longest-running major in pool, the US Open has a history extending back almost 50 years and has been won by just about every big name in the sport. The tournament assembles 256 players from around the world as they do battle to lift the famous Barry Behrman trophy and claim their share of a \$300,000 prize fund.

The action is played across 33 tables as players battle to first reach the straight-knockout last 16, and then to claim a title viewed as one of the biggest prizes a player can win.

MOSCONI CUP BALLY'S

Event Overview

The must-see event in pool, the Mosconi Cup pits five-player teams from Europe and USA head-to-head in front of a raucous atmosphere.

Three players on each team qualify through their position on the Nineball World Rankings, with 2 spots on each team reserved for the team captains to complete the roster with wildcard picks.

Played over four days, teams play a series of doubles and singles matches with the first to reach 11 crowned Mosconi Cup champions. All matches are race to 5, alternate break.
